### **100-Days' Action Plan & Achievements:**

- **VVIP Visit:**

Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Hon'ble Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India visited Tripura on 29th May, 2018 and held review meeting on Doubling Farmers' Income.

- **Kisan Kalyan Karyashala :**

As a part of National Programme, one day duration "Kisan Kalyan Karyashala" was organized throughout the state on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2018. Total 404 nos. of programmes were organized in 58 blocks, where 25,884 nos. of farmers attended.

- **Distribution of Production Inputs & Soil Health Cards**

Looking at the production requirement of major crops during Kharif season, 208.09 MT certified seeds of Paddy, Groundnut, Sesamum, Jute and Millets were distributed to the farmers, against the target of 137.50 MT, i.e 51% more and 964 MT of chemical fertilizers (Urea, SSP & MOP) were distributed to the farmers, against the target of 600 MT, which is 61% more. During 100 days, 5197 nos. of soil samples were tested the target of 4000 nos., which is 30% more and 1728 nos. of Soil Health Cards were distributed to the farmers

- **Farm Mechanization:**

Within 100 days, arrangement has been made for distribution of 300 Power tillers. Till date 290 Power tillers have been distributed and more 100 nos. will be distributed shortly.

To disseminate agricultural technology at farmers' door step, 36 "Krishak Bandhu Kendras" have been targeted to be established in 36 Agril. Subdivisions in a phased manner and 5 Kendras will be set up within 100 days. In the mean time, one 'Krishak Bandhu Kendra' was opened on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 at Chataria village under Matabari Agri. Subdivision. Arrangements have been made to open remaining 4 Krishak Bandhu Kendras at Belonia, Jampuijala, Halahali and Pecharthal.
